- It is necessary to be a non-EU/EEA/Swiss citizen.
  - It is important to have a business idea that has the potential for growth that is innovative and scalable.
  - You will be required to provide a comprehensive business plan that outlines the business idea, market analysis, financial projections, and the potential impact on the Lithuanian economy as well.
  - The Startup Committee must approve the business idea before it can move forward.
- O Demonstrate that they have sufficient financial resources to support themselves and their business. A minimum of €800 per month is required to cover the costs of the project.

In order for non-EU entrepreneurs to establish and grow their businesses in Lithuania, the Lithuania Startup Visa is a great opportunity. With the help of this visa, Lithuania is hoping to attract innovative startups and contribute to the dynamic economy of the country.

#### O Visa-Free Travel:

Travelling within the Schengen Area is visa-free, enabling you to conduct business across Europe and explore new markets.

#### O Pathway to Residency and Citizenship:

You can apply for permanent residency or become a Lithuanian citizen after five years of legal residency in the country.

#### O Family Reunification:

If you wish to join your family in Lithuania, they will have the same residency rights as you.

#### Supportive Business Environment:

You will be able to benefit from Lithuania's supportive business ecosystem, including government incentives, tax reductions, and funding opportunities in order to grow your business.
